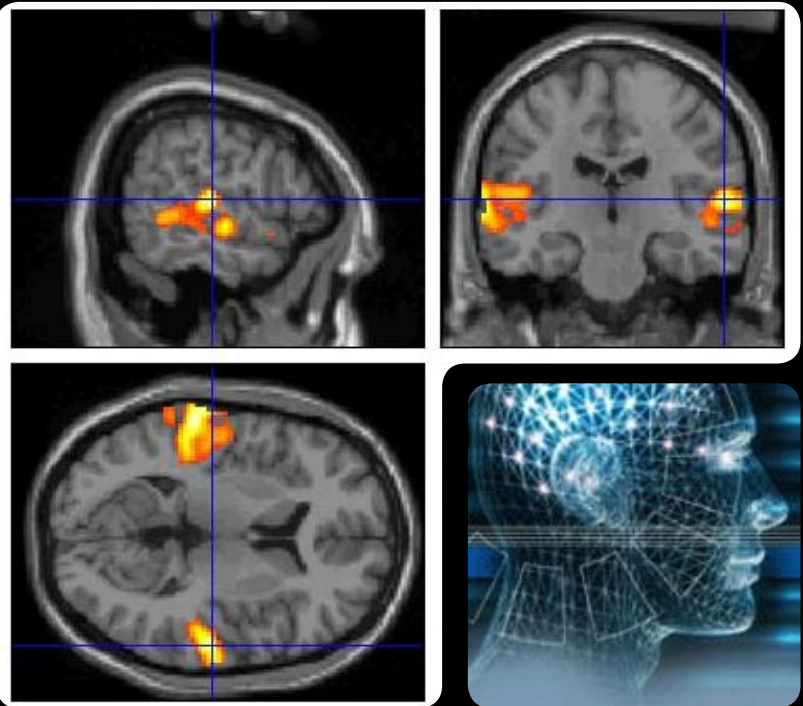

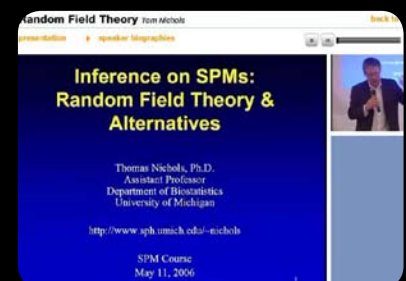
Mapping, or SPM, is a software programme used to map brain activity. The SPM short course is taught to neuroscientists at the UCL Institute of Neurology, who promote teaching and research of the highest quality in neurology and the neurosciences.

The Institute held a 2-day training course, which was attended by neurological researchers from all over the world, including students from as far away as the US and China.
