By employing the latest video and media streaming technologies our Virtual Meetings Platform (VMP) recreates the experience of attending a meeting, seminar or medical briefing in-person.

Video footage of presenters is synchronised to their presentation material whether it is PowerPoint™ or any other desktop based demonstration.

A range of interactive features can be developed and included on your site including audience surveys, live discussion boards & quizzes to check delegates' understanding.

You can also secure your content with registration and login systems, retrieve tenable learning data and add value to your online presentations by making them CME accredited.

This can be achieved through challenging your online attendees to answer a series of multiple choice questions or by asking them to assess a case based scenario.

Standard Features

Login & Registration

Adaptable registration systems allowing participants direct access to site content or requiring administrator approval. Via an administrator login on the site

the client can retrieve all user registration and viewing data.

Meeting Information and Presentation Index Pages

Custom built landing pages can be designed to appear as part of your existing site, be client or sponsor branded and allow you to provide background information and learning objectives. Searchable presentation indexes allow users to navigate to individual sessions and presentations quickly.

Presentation Info Panel

Each presentation panel displays additional information about the presentation and speaker including biographies, abstracts and photos.

Presentation Player Console

The console contains the speaker video synchronised to PowerPoint™ slides or desktop screen capture. The video or slide elements can be zoomed which is particularly useful for highly detailed slides or desktop software demonstrations.

Synchronised PowerPoint™ Slide Presentations

The synchronised slide functionality simulates the experience of an in-person PowerPoint™ presentation by placing an image of each slide in the player console window. This automatically changes the slide



based on the progress of the video and users can also scroll forwards or backwards.

Audience Interaction

Options for engaging your audience include surveys and question submission. Survey feedback is collated for review in the admin area and questions asked by your online delegates can be directed to an email address where an expert resource is available to respond.

Viewing Statistics

Detailed reports on participants viewing progress and site usage can be setup. The data is available through a secure password-protected admin area and is viewable in HTML or downloadable in Microsoft Excel format.
