What data do we collect?

Through or in connection with this website we, AVT Ltd., collect and use personal data such as:

How do we collect your data?

We do this in two primary ways:

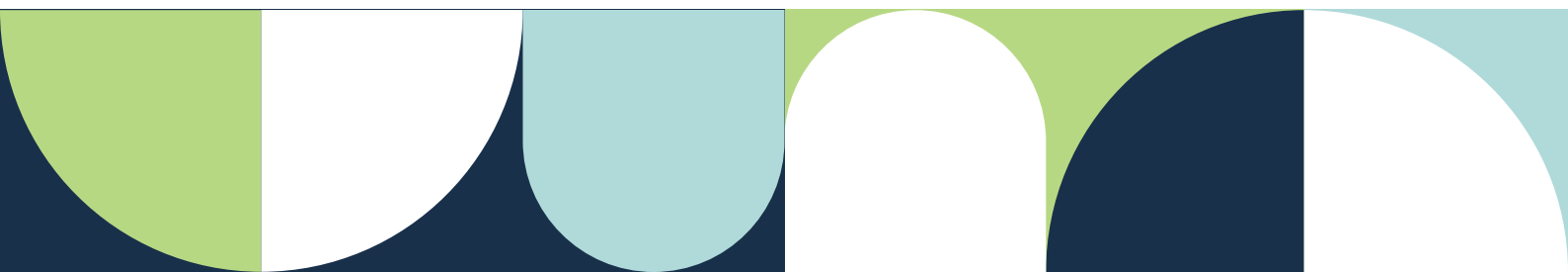
- If you send us a question or other communication, we use that information to respond to your request;

How will we use or share your data?

We only use personal information collected by this website for the purposes of providing event services, in recruitment and employment of people and informing users or clients of our services to the degree you consent to. We do not share information with third parties to enable them to contact you for marketing purposes and we will never share your data without your permission.

How do we store your data?

We store your personal data for as long as required to fulfil the purposes outlined in this privacy policy, unless a longer or shorter retention period is required or permitted by law.



What are your data protection rights?

AVT Ltd. would like to make sure you're fully aware of your data protection rights and how you're entitled to contact us regarding any personal data submitted or collected by our website. Every user is entitled to the following:

- **The right to access** – you have the right to request AVT Ltd. for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.
- **The right to rectification** – you have the right to request that AVT Ltd. correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request AVT Ltd. to complete information you believe is incomplete.
- **The right to erasure** – You have the right to request that AVT Ltd. erase your personal data, under certain conditions.
- **The right to restrict processing** – You have the right to request that AVT Ltd restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- **The right to object to processing** – You have the right to object to AVT Ltd. processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- **The right to data portability** – You have the right to request that AVT Ltd. transfers the data we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

What are cookies?

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard internet log information and visitor behaviour information. When you visit our website, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology. For more information, visit allaboutcookies.org

How do we use cookies?

Our company uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your experience on our website, these include:

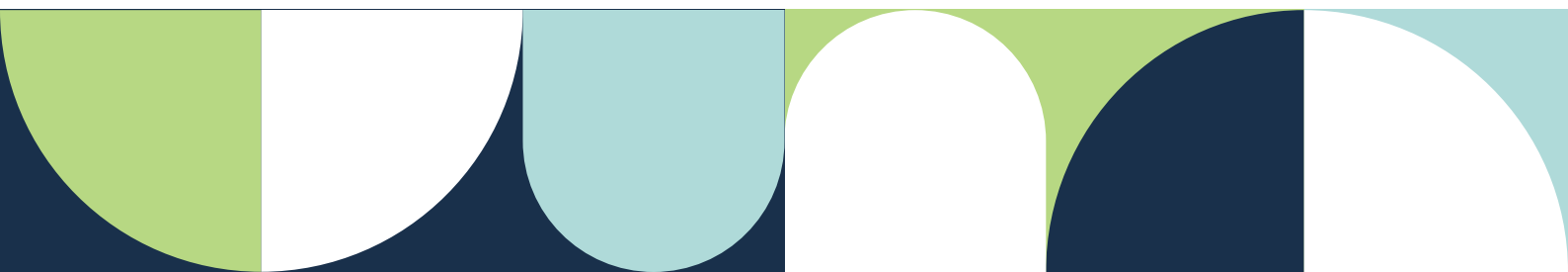
- Website performance improvement – we track how users interact with our site so we can improve the functionality and design. We do not collect IP addresses or personalised information. We only track anonymised website interactions.
